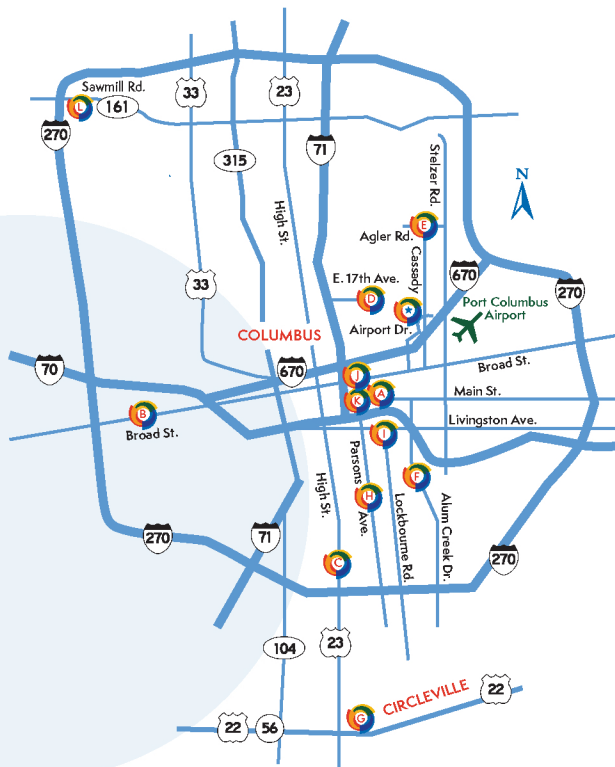

Prenatal Care

Studies show the earlier you seek prenatal care, the better your chances for a healthy pregnancy and delivery. At PrimaryOne Health, the Prenatal Care Program is part of our full range of quality care through which expectant mothers receive high quality care from the very beginning of their pregnancy. Services include medical and psychosocial evaluations, follow-up visits with physicians and certified nurse-midwives, as well as standard prenatal lab work. And, in the weeks leading up to delivery, we offer childbirth preparation classes, complete with individualized attention and goal-setting.

Healthcare for the Homeless

PrimaryOne Health offers the **Healthcare for the Homeless Program** that provides homeless persons with complete health care. The program helps persons that live in a supervised public or private shelter designed to be temporary, who do not have a regular place to sleep at night or have housing but may lose their ability to stay there within 14 days.

The program offers prescription assistance, health education, transportation and all health services provided.
